Hello,  
when resizing images, they are not correctly resized they got squeezed and look stretched out.

here is the code to be replaced:  
com\_estateagent/includes/gallery/upload.gallery.php

code to be edited:

Hallo Samantha,

wenn deine Kamera 2:3-Bilder liefert, dann stelle das Verhältnis der komprimierten Bilder doch einfach auf ein Vielfaches von 2:3 ein (Bsp. 400:600). Das Gleiche machst du bei den Thumbnails. Du mußt dich nur entscheiden, was dir wichtiger ist, die Breite des Bildes, oder die Höhe. Dieser Wert sollte die Grundlage für die Berechnung des Verhältnises bilden.

Bist du sicher, 2:3 - nicht 3:2? Normalerweise ist doch das Bild breiter, als hoch.

Ich weiß nicht, ob das 100%-ig funktioniert, aber einen Versuch ist es wert, oder? Wichtig ist das Verhältnis des Ursprungsbildes zum Endergebnis, das sollte/muss immer gleich sein, damit es zu keinen Stauchungen kommt. Falls du doch mal ein anderes Verhältnis nutzen willst, kannst du dir ja die Möglichkeit offen halten und es unter dem Punkt "user" in der Konfiguration von ME explizit erlauben, dass Verhältnis zu ändern.

Im sorry my German sucks bit time, but I have the exactly same configurations but it does not work.

If I upload vertical pictures it will stretch them into 450px wide and 338px height. Also the individual image settings does not work, if I try to use them it always drops me out from the bind & upload. At least with Firefox with Safari the whole admin does not work and I do not have IE as Im on mac, but does it work any better with that?

perhaps this is to do with php5 ??? meaning it does not work with php5 ?

hi,

In my version 1.1.0, i found two problems :

- first one, the keep proportion parameter value is never "1" so pictures will always stretch them into fixed size.
- second one, "vertical" pictures are squeezed because of the wrong calculated ratio

here is the code to be replaced:

I think in case of small pictures it is important that the upload.gallery.php should use \$destWidth and not \$width. So I did the following two little changes:

In line 211 the code...

```
imagecopyresized($dst_img, $src_img, 0, 0, 0, 0, $width, (int)$destHeight, $srcWidth, $srcHeight);
```

is replaced by:

```
imagecopyresized($dst_img, $src_img, 0, 0, 0, 0, $destWidth, $destHeight, $srcWidth, $srcHeight);
```

in line 243 code...

```
imagecopyresampled($dst_img, $src_img, 0, 0, 0, 0, $width, (int)$destHeight, $srcWidth, $srcHeight);
```

is replaced by:

```
imagecopyresampled($dst_img, $src_img, 0, 0, 0, 0, $destWidth, $destHeight, $srcWidth, $srcHeight);
```

Now your small pictures should keep small, so that we don't have to view great pixels. Larger pictures are resized down to the allowed maximum. Besides everything keeps in proportion if you took care about the \$prop=0 bug too (also mentioned in this thread).

Besides the maximum Width is checked but not the maximum Height. So if I allowed uploads of 640 width and 480 height it would be possible to upload 640 width and 2000 height for example. You may solve it by

replacing line 182...

```
$ratio = $srcWidth / $width;
```

with...

```
$ratiowidth = $srcWidth / $width;
```

```
$ratioheight = $srcHeight / $height;
```

```
$ratio = max($ratiowidth,$ratioheight);
```

If you set size to 800x800 now, your users can upload 800x600 and 600x800 for example.

Did you already try to set thumb creation to 1 for testing? I ask this, because the changes I proposed relate to `resizeIMG` function. This function is used for your image resizing and also for thumbnail resizing, so that there should be no difference. I doubt that some parameters are not given correctly to this function for thumb resizing but I don't know. Please set thumbs temporarily to 1 and tell me what happens, if you upload some pictures then. If you want to check the parameters given to the `resize` function, you could also put some echos in front of line 108 like:

```
echo "create thumb: ".$cfg."<br>";  
echo "thumb width: ".$cfg."<br>";  
echo "thumb height: ".$cfg."<br>";  
echo "thumb proportion: ".$cfg."<br>";  
echo "thumb quality: ".$cfg;  
sleep(10);
```

When uploading an image you will see your thumbnail parameters for 10 seconds then. What values do you see?

@0zz1: Ok, the parameters are fine. Thanks for the link, it was a help for me. I downloaded some of your images and thumbnails. The files have the correct height and width. Thumbnails: 67x90 and 90x67. Images: 338x450 and 450x338. But when the thumbnails are displayed at your object description or catalogue, everything is displayed at a width of 90, so that the bathroom (this file has a width of 67) gets enlarged to 90 and the resolution looks bad. A lot of functions need to be changed. I don't know how to solve that. Sorry.
