I have found it! :woohoo:

here is the solution:

create a new field in the database in the table 'jos\_estateagent' with the name 'test' (type: DECIMAL ; Length: 10,2 ; Collation: - ;NULL: Not Null)

in the language file add this lines:

```
DEFINE('_EA_OBJ_TEST','Test');  
DEFINE('_EAB_OBJ_TEST','Test');
```

in the file admin.estateagent.html.php in the folder administrator/components/com\_estateagent at line about 400 add a new field, something like this:

```
<div class="tr2">  
    <div class="td1"><?php echo _EAB_OBJ_TEST; ?></div>  
    <div class="td2"><input type="Text" name="test" size="7" class="inputbox" maxlength="10" value="<?php  
echo $obj->test; ?>" /> <?php echo $params; ?></div>  
</div>
```

in the file class.estateagent.php in the folder administrator/components/com\_estateagent at line about 30 add:

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var \$test = 0;

at line about 116 add:

```
_EA_OBJ_TEST => $this->test,
```

at line about 186 add:

```
if($this->test!=0.00) $this-> test .= " ".$ea_measure;
```
