Basically, if you need this module very bad, you can make it by yourself, no big deal at all ...

step one:

rename (in language files) one of checkbox fields you're not using at all or very rare (let's say a sat/tv or adsl or underfloor heating) to: sold

step two:

install an ea hot module (or overwrite some unused module with hot module files .php and .xml, if you're already using hot module)

step three:

change this part: AND hot=1

from module php file, to AND dsl=1 (well, of course if dsl is the part you changed to SOLD)

that should do the trick

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there is more hussle to marking the sold object in a nice way, for that you should play with your templete file and write something like :

dsl=1 echo SOLD

where SOLD should be the text or image announcimng that object is sold ...

remeber, this is just a temporary solution, while waiting for additional field and checkbox is added in next ME version for SOLD object purpose ... of course, you can add it by yourself, but you should play with a lot of files and with database ofcourse ... so i'm not sure it worth the effort

anyhow, i should suggest the most simple solution: make an image similar to nopic.png (the one that is showed when no pictures uploaded) saying SOLD and make it first or only one of the object pictures ... you can even use some auto-photo resizer tools whic are allowing you to add a watermark, so your watermark should say SOLD writen in nise big red letters over the picture of the object

right?

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
