Hi there,

EAImproved is a fork of EstateAgent, which was the predecessor of MisterEstate. EstateAgent was developed by me, and so ~95% of the sourcecode of EAImproved is my work.

This greek guy grabed this old code, added a few new functions and now tries to make money with it (with our work!).

An example: if you want the full version (with GoogleMaps support), you will have to pay for it("donate"). MisterEstate has this function too, but you don't have to pay for, because MisterEstate is free and will be free!

So, if you ask me for my opinion:

don't pay for something you can get for free and don't support this kind of impertinent behavior!

If maybe someone told you, that MisterEstate is dead, don't belive him! We are currently busy with development of a complete new MisterEstate version which will be compatible with Joomla 1.5 and will have a lot of new features.

Only show a little patience!
