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Ok, here's what we've found so far. Yes, the upload install seemed for some reason set permissions to 666. We set all permissions to 755 and that now allows the media upload to work.

There are a number of files missing of which we verified the zip and they are not there.

These are graphic images as follows and are being called by the ME program and are trying to make call them from the root image directory rather than administrator/images where they are located:

These files are

delete\_f2.png  
copy\_f2.png  
mediamanager.png

To correct this in the short term we moved copies of these files to the root/images directory from the administrator/images directory.

The Joomla installer for ME 1.10 also failed to upload many other files which we corrected once found such as the loadingAnimation.gif which is to be installed in the thickbox directory.

The ME image scroller mod also created a folder called mod\_me\_latest\_img\_scroller which was also giving an error. After verifying our error logs it was apparent that the directory was named created wrong and should be named mod\_me\_latest\_img

Using our error logs as reference we corrected the missing files and placements. This has seemed to correct many issues.

Not sure if this is a ME issue or a Joomla issue, but this is the only mod/componet that we installed that gives us this type of problems. We've installed many others and all worked fine. So I tend to believe there are a few issues missed on the ME 1.10 version which I'm sure will be looked at.

Once again, thanks for a great program as it is working well so far. In fact we have completed the French lang file for 1.1 but are still verifying full function and will upload this soon.

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Hi! I'm from Russia. I had a similar problem. Support of my hosting company helped solve the problem. Here's a rough translation into English:

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"At our server used by Russian Apache, which by default recodes all the data from many Russians encoding used by the customer, in one standard to which they are stored on the server. At our server is windows-1251. Binary data should not be subjected to perekodirovaniyu, respectively, this function should be switched off. For that you need in the catalogue, which is downloadable script, create a file .htaccess and put him in the directive, which isolates recoding.

CharsetRecodeMultipartForms off

This directive disables recoding data sent from html-form format multipart / form-data (which is used to upload files to a server using html-forms). Keep in mind that if in form, which takes data from a script with disconnected conversion, there are text fields, then you have to convert their own."

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Total: if your site is working on localized APACHE use a specified way. File .htaccess need to put in the folder / components / com\_estateagent / includes / gallery
