You have to use the same url that you déclaré in the site config (\$mosConfig_live_site) to log in in the administrator panel.

Means if you have many url that points on your site (ie yoursite.com, yoursite.fr, yoursite.info), use the main one you declared in the configuration.php page to log in in the administrator panel.

You should be free to go in the gallery !
